Initial CT lung screening Follow-up CT lung screening

1. Lung screening eligibility/criteria:

- Age 50-80 years or age 50-77 years if a Medicare beneficiary
- Tobacco smoking history of at least 20 pack-years
- Current smoker or former smoker who has quit ≤ 15 years ago
- Asymptomatic (no acute symptoms of lung cancer)

2. Completion of a lung cancer screening counseling and the initial shared decision making visit by physician that includes documentation of the following:

- Written order
- Determination of patient eligibility
- Disclosure of risks vs. benefits
- Ability or willingness to undergo diagnosis and treatment
- Information about the importance of smoking abstinence and tobacco cessation interventions
- Information about the importance of adherence to annual screening program (if criteria met)
