

## PHONE SCRIPT FOR CALL-INS - PATIENT SCREENING: FOREIGN TRAVEL/EBOLA EXPOSURE

(Example: Feel free to adapt)

PHONE ANSWER	/ TRIAGE:
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**Operator:** "Thank you for calling \_\_xxx\_\_, how may I help you?"

**Patient:** "I want to make an appointment for "

"I have symptoms including \_\_xxx\_\_\_"

**Operator:** Demographics collected, PCP of choice selected.......

"Which day / time are you interested in coming in, and what is the reason for your

## **ACTION:**

<u>IF</u> the reason for appointment includes words such as the following that raise the need for further screening:

- Fever, aches, pains
- Recent travel out of the country
- I'm worried (or I think) I've been exposed to Ebola or an infection

THEN trigger the use of the Screening questions below:

1	Has patient been/traveled outside the US within the last 30 days?

3	Has anyone in your family or a close contact been outside the US within the last <u>30</u> days?

5	Have you had potential contact with a person with known or suspected Ebola Virus

## **FOLLOW-UP:**

If NO is the answer to ALL questions above, STOP. Proceed with appointment scheduling

**If YES** is the answer to **ANY** question above, **AND** they or a contact have traveled to a country on CDC's watch list for Ebola (currently including Guinea, Liberia, Sierra Leone), then use the following script:

"Based off of your answers to the questions I just asked, you will need additional screening and medical care at an emergency room".

"You will need to hang up & call 911, or you may stay on the line, and I will be happy to assist you".
