Early Detection is the Key

One in eight women will be diagnosed with breast cancer during her lifetime. Breast cancer accounts for more than 30 percent of all cancers found in women and it is not selective. The majority of women diagnosed with breast cancer have no family history of the disease and while it occurs more frequently in women who are over the age of 50, younger women are at risk, too.

The Basic Steps of Breast Care

Regular breast examinations by a healthcare provider: Should be part of your regular physical and performed every three years beginning at age 20 and yearly after age 40.

Breast self-examination: Beginning at age 20, women should perform breast self-examinations to be more aware of how their breasts look and feel. A Breast Center healthcare provider can advise you of the best methods for performing breast self-examinations and provide you with educational materials.

Routine mammograms: As one of the most important tools in the early detection of breast cancer, this low-dose X-ray can reveal both harmless and cancerous growths when they are too small to be detected by you or your healthcare provider.
